VESTRY VITALS

The Vestry met on March 19 for its regularly scheduled meeting on the third Monday of each month. One item always on the agenda is the financial statements. Since the Behold campaign began, we have had two statements to review.

We can report that through the end of February, Emmanuel's revenue and expense statement had a small budget surplus. We graciously had some parishioners finish making their 2011 pledges in January and February. Since more of these payments have come in compared to what the Finance Committee and the Vestry had budgeted, there is a surplus. Please do not feel left out if you have not finished making your payments for 2011.

Payments are also still being made on Behold pledges. About 90.4% of the pledge funds have been collected. We thank everyone who has completed their pledge payments and look forward for others to continue making their pledge payments so that payment of the expenses of the addition and remodeling are paid in full. If anyone would like to make any additional payments for Behold, please contact Nancy Benz, Assistant Treasurer, at (314) 961-2393 extension 210.

The Vestry had further discussions in regard to the goals for 2012. Hospitality was cited as central to why we each are members of the Emmanuel community. Hospitality is how we accept others as well as acceptance of our diversity (personal, theological, political, etcetera) and also what we all can contribute for Emmanuel.

AIR (Attract, Integrate, Retain), Formation and Stewardship are identified as the areas of strengthening a hospitable community for all. In that regard the Vestry members have been assigned to further enhance the work these groups are doing with the outcome to discover treasures in our midst.

We seek to be a community where the essence of Emmanuel is welcoming, open, warm, spiritual, diverse, multi-generational, and faith centered for ever changing participants. We want the outcomes to reflect our Mission Statement of:


SECOND ANNUAL PLANT SALE

We learned of the death on March 23 of parishioner **June Compton Banks** and extend our sympathy to her family. A service will be held for her at Jefferson Barracks in early June.




