# Ann Marie Ruhlin Retires from Children's Choir Program

When I started directing Junior Choir the first time in 1986, I was 38 and had children who were 18 months and 2 months old. The children who were in choir in those early days are now in their 30s and 40s and many have families of their own. I have only to look at my own children to know that almost 30 years have gone by since then and I'm certainly no longer anywhere close to 38. I am still working full-time and plan to keep doing that for at least the next few years. The truth is that the 14 hour days on Wednesday of every week are getting harder for me.

It is with great sadness that I have decided to step away from directing the children's choirs. I have absolutely loved working with the children for the past 5 years and will treasure my memories of the wonderful music and Christmas Plays we created together. There were only 6 children in Junior Choir and 7 in Cherub Choir that first fall; last year, a total of 35 children participated in the two choirs. I'm looking forward to being the children's most enthusiastic audience member going forward. I can't wait to watch them grow and hear the music they will create as young ministers to the parish. 
