**United Thank Offering (UTO)** is a ministry of the Episcopal Church for the mission of the whole church. Through UTO, men, women and children nurture the habit of giving daily thanks to God. These prayers of thanksgiving start when we recognize and name our many daily blessings.

The funds collected for 2016 distributed in 32 grants including:

Trinity Episcopal Church, St. Louis, Missouri:

To expand the food ministry of the church by adding an afternoon meal to the Thursday food pantry session and to replace Styrofoam items with washable dishware. This past year, the food pantry provided food for 9,000 individuals. Many of the patrons are the working poor or homeless. The grant will enable the food ministry to purchase the dishware, the storage racks, tables, and other

equipment needed for sustainability. By using reusable dishware and utensils, the food ministry is being a faithful steward of God's creation.

A project in San Diego to help people learn to address the relationship between fear and bigotry in the Community. It examines how faith encourages us to approach our own and others' fear to move forward to healing.

# 7th Annual Miss Carol's Brunch for the Homeless, Dec. 18th.

Carol Bledsoe was one of a kind. She was the friendly face at church on Sunday that always made you feel welcome. She believed the best in people, and this was evident in her work. Carol was a parish administrator at the Episcopal Cathedral in Downtown St. Louis. Through her work, Carol constantly saw the many needs of the homeless that sought shelter and help at the Cathedral.

Whether it was buying gloves, finding a resource, or just listening to their stories, she would do her best to meet their needs. Eventually, Carol convinced a local doughnut shop to donate their day old product, and a daily breakfast club for the homeless was created. It was called "Club Cathedral." She soon became known as "Miss Carol," a trusted friend of the homeless.

On December 19, 2002, Carol was tragically killed outside of her office by a homeless man she had once helped. The next year, "Ms. Carol's Christmas Brunch for the Homeless" was created. Originally, this brunch was served at the Cathedral for the homeless that Carol cared so deeply for. It was a way to remember Carol and continue her important mission. For 6 years, the Emmanuel youth group and members of Christ Church helped at the brunch for the homeless in honor of Carol. We continue that tradition to honor Carol with our own brunch to raise money for the Miss Carol homeless breakfast program at the Cathedral that is held every Saturday of the year.

This brunch is a great reminder of what is truly important around Christmas time. It brings together the Emmanuel family and truly makes a difference to the St. Louis community.
