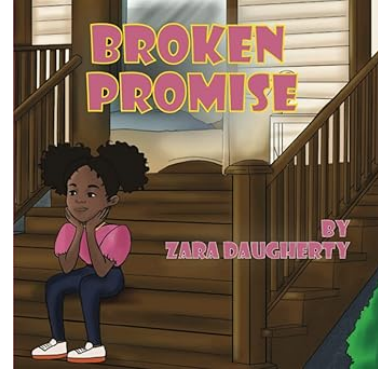


Broken Promises
